To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Albert Girouard, a citizen of the United States, residing at Leominster, in the county of Worcester, State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bandeau or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Figure 1 is an edge view of the bandeau; and
Fig. 2 is a front view thereof.

The dominant features of my design reside in the portions shown in full lines.

I claim:—

The ornamental design for a bandeau or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
